### **1. Entries:**

**PLEASE READ! No matter whether you choose to send a check or pay with a credit card, PLEASE USE EQUESTRIAN ENTRIES.COM to log on all your info. It is free to register on the site. You can type in ALL entry info and then a) PRINT your entry form and MAIL with CHECK/Coggins/Signature page OR b) use a credit card to enter. Please contact Georges at EquestrianEntries.com for further directions to enter/pay electronically. If you just print an entry form you are NOT entered, your information is in the system, but you are NOT officially entered. You will only be officially entered when your check reaches the secretary. If after typing in all your information you use a credit card to pay for your entry, you are officially entered. All entry fees include a \$25 non-refundable office fee. Preliminary riders/Owners/Agents must include copy of current USEF Membership card or pay the USEF non-member fee. BN competitors who are not USEA members must pay additional \$25 non-member fee with entry. USEA FEES, starter and drugs/med fees DO NOT apply to the Starter Level. Starter competitors are also exempt from USEA membership/non-membership fees. Please include a legible email address on entry, all communications will be electronic. All monies paid between Aug 7-15 must be paid in cash/money order/cashier's check. All changes must be in writing (e-mail) \$75 returned check fee. \$50 charge for missing pinny. Refunds: Before C.D.- Entry less \$25 non-refundable office fee; After C.D.- NONE. Competition cancellation None. Neg. Coggins within 12 months required for all horses; include with entry.**

**Address: Pratt's Wayne Woods Forest Preserve, 6N941 Dunham Rd Wayne, IL 60184 is located 35 miles due west of Chicago. From South: I-88 (Tollway) to Farnsworth North, travel 12 miles. Farnsworth becomes Kirk Rd then becomes Dunham Rd. From North: I-90 to Rte 59. Proceed south on Rt. 59 for 7 miles. to Stearns Rd. West to Dunham Rd. Turn left. Pratt's Wayne Woods Forest Preserve is on east side of Dunham Rd (south of Stearns Rd).**

## 9. Cross-Country:

(approx distances) P-2600 m @ 520 mpm. T-2300 m @ 420 mpm. N-2000 m @ 350 mpm. BN-2000 m @ 350 mpm, 14-16 fences, max. ht. 2'7", . Courses: Average difficulty. . **Starter: Max height 2'3". XC will include option at water jump. XC NOT TIMED.** Courses: HT average difficulty. Starter inviting, straight forward, great opportunity to introduce green horses to a real cross-country course at introductory height jumps. Galloping lanes Aeravated. No motorized vehicles on xc without permission of day sec'y. Those with permission will be given special ID.

## 10. Other Information:

Cross-country course closes July 30 sundown. Divisions may be cancelled/combined if entries insufficient. Food on grounds. Dogs must be leashed. In order for entries to be considered complete, MUST have at least: complete date of birth, 3 mandatory signatures, current Coggins, USEA number BN-P (or \$25 non-member fee at BN). For P USEF # & copy of USEF card for owner/ rider/agent, if the same, MUST indicate (or \$30 non-member fee, owner/ rider/agent) and one check or credit card payment to cover all fees. Entries completed/corrected too late to process/schedule will be put on wait list. Riders under 18 years old must have parent's ORIGINAL signature on Forest Preserve waiver in order to pick up packet. If parent will not be on show grounds when Jr. is picking up packet, print waiver from WDHT website. BRING SIGNED WAIVER TO THE SHOW OFFICE. DO NOT MAIL/SEND WAIVER.
