All levels: **No increase from 2007 or 2008** \$395 (includes mandatory stabling per Lamplight Equestrian Center,) FEH, 4YEH, 5YEH to be held Thursday afternoon (See Fees above). Changes after C.D. \$25.00 & are at discretion of organizing committee. Double entries: Not accepted. No matter what level you ride, entry must have rider, owner/agent, trainer signatures. USEA membership required at N/T/P/I. BN non-members of USEA must pay \$25 non-member fee. I/P USEF non-member fee \$30. Refunds: Before C.D, FULL REFUND when received by 9:00 PM Eastern Standard Time July 28. After C.D. \$125.00 stabling fee refunded through August 9 Eastern Standard Time, 9:00PM. After August 9, no refunds. Written withdrawal, e-mail or mail, must be received by SHOW SECRETARY by 9:00 PM Eastern Standard Time JULY 28 NO phone calls or faxes accepted for withdrawal. Competition cancellation-full refund if show cancelled due to low entries. No refunds if show cancelled due to weather/disaster. Neg. Coggins (drawn after Aug.17, 2008) required for ALL horses: Must accompany entry.

Farnsworth becomes Kirk Rd then becomes Dunham Rd. Lamplight Equestrian Center on west side of Dunham Rd. (South of Stearns Rd). From North: I-90 to Rte 59. Proceed south on Rt. 59 7 mi. to Stearns Rd. West to Dunham Rd. Turn left. Lamplight on west side of Dunham Rd (south of Stearns Rd).

**10) OTHER INFORMATION:** After closing date (July 28) and through Sunday, August 9 at 9:00 PM Eastern Standard Time, \$125.00 stabling fee will be refunded if proper notification is received by secretary. After 9:00 PM August 9, there will be no refunds.

Cross-country course closes sundown July 30. Divisions may be cancelled/combined if entries insufficient. Food on grounds. Dogs must be leashed. In order for entries to be considered complete, MUST have at least stabling form/request, complete date of birth, 3 mandatory signatures, current Coggins, USEA #BN-I (or \$25 non-member fee at BN). For I/P USEF # & copy of USEF card for owner and rider, if the same, MUST indicate (or \$30 non-member fee, owner &/or rider) and one check to cover all fees or credit card payment. Entries completed/corrected too late to process/schedule will be put on wait list.
